- i. **PG (MD/MS)** A total no of 2713 applications were received by the CENTAC office, of whom 52 PG students were admitted to the various courses at PIMS through counseling, relevant records have been submitted to CENTAC office and National Medical Council of India, New Delhi.
- ii. **MBBS Admissions:** CENTAC had received 5130 applications, as per the directive of the permanent Admission committee (Govt. of Puducherry) the procedure of admission through CENTAC for admission to the I MBBS (2023) course was followed. Through the process of counseling, admission was given to 90 Management students, 04 NRI Students, 56 State Govt. Quota students, and their relevant records submitted to Pondicherry University and the CENTAC / Admissions Committee (Govt. of Puducherry).

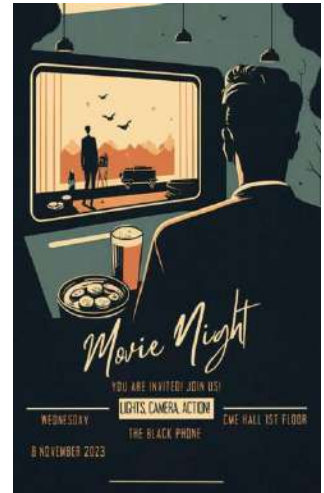

POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

PG Admission:

Pondicherry Institute Medical Sciences offers postgraduate courses in twenty disciplines with a total annual intake of 62 seats. A total of 52 postgraduate students (MD/MS 2023 batch) for specialty courses were admitted.

Submission of Dissertation Protocol:

The dissertation protocols for the MD/MS 2022 batch, comprising 46 postgraduates, were submitted to Pondicherry University in May 2023.

The dissertation protocols for the MD/MS 2023 batch, comprising 51 postgraduates, were submitted to Pondicherry University in March 2024.

Submission of PG (MD/MS) Dissertation:

Two postgraduates of 2020 batch submitted their dissertation to Pondicherry University in June and September 2023 respectively.

Pondicherry University Examinations:

July 2023

- The Postgraduate pass percentage in the Pondicherry University examination was 93% (42 out of 45 postgraduate students), Thirteen departments achieved 100% pass, including Anaesthesiology, Anatomy, Community Medicine, Dermatology, Microbiology, Pediatrics, Psychiatry, Respiratory Medicine, Radiodiagnosis, ENT, OBG, Ophthalmology and Orthopaedics.

December 2023

- The Postgraduate pass percentage in the Pondicherry University examination was 60% (3 out of 5 postgraduate students).

BCLS/ ACLS Training programme:

District Residency Program:

From February 2023 to January 2024, 48 postgraduate students of 2021 batch completed their District Residency Program at the District Health System/ Hospital in Pondicherry District.
