## **REGISTRAR OFFICE**

#### 1. Co-ordination of Admissions to UG & PG courses at PIMS Medical and Nursing College - 2022-23

As per directive of CENTAC (Centralized Admission Committee) Govt. of Puducherry the Admissions to UG/PG courses at PIMS was completed.

- i. **PG (MD/MS)** A total no of 1,619 applications were received by the CENTAC office, of whom 46 PG students were admitted to the various courses at PIMS through counseling, relevant records has been submitted to CENTAC office and National Medical Council of India, New Delhi.
- ii. **MBBS Admissions**: CENTAC had received **6,360** applications, as per the directive of the permanent Admission committee (Govt. of Pondicherry) the procedure of admission through CENTAC for admission to the I MBBS (2022) course was followed. Through the process of counseling, admission was given to Management students, NRI Students, State Govt. Quota students, and their relevant records submitted to Pondicherry University and the CENTAC / Admissions Committee (Govt. of Pondicherry).
- iii. PIMS CON admissions There were 50 students (50%) admitted under the Management Quota, remaining 50 students (State Govt. Quota) admitted through counseling conducted by CENTAC and relevant records submitted to CENTAC office and Pondicherry University
- iv. Allied Health Sciences BPT -20, MRIT -13 and MLT -13 students are admitted through CENTAC counseling for the academic year 2022-23.
- **2.** Issue of Certificates: More than 600 certificates were issued to students i.e. Bonafide Certificates, Fees structure, Course Attempt and Conduct certificates etc.

## POST GRADUATE

#### PG Admission:

Pondicherry Institute Medical Sciences has postgraduate courses in twenty disciplines with an annual intake of 62 seats. A total of 46 postgraduate students (MD/MS 2022 batch) for specialty courses and one M.Ch Plastic Surgery student (2021 batch) were admitted.

The Board of Governors has granted permission for increase of seats in the following departments for the academic year 2022 -2023.

#### **Submission of Dissertation Protocol:**

The dissertation protocols of 49 MD/MS postgraduates and one M.Ch Plastic Surgery candidate belonging to 2021 batch were submitted to Pondicherry University in November 2022 and February 2023 respectively.

#### Submission of PG (MD/MS) Dissertation:

## **MEDICAL EDUCATION**

The activities of the Medical Education Unit during the year 2022-23 are summarized below -

### 1. Orientation programs:

a. The Undergraduate Orientation Program for the MBBS batch 2021 admission and 2022 were held over a week from 7<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> April 2022 and 5<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> December 2022 respectively. Both the event commenced with a Welcome Program, and included the NMC mandated elements for the Orientation, including visits of campus, community and city facilities of importance to the students. This was followed by formal classes for the students. All 300 students admitted participated in this Orientation program

b. The First Clinical Year Orientation was conducted for 150 students on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> March 2023. In addition to sessions aimed to facilitate the transition from pre-clinical to clinical studies, extended sessions on communication skills, stress management and revision of skills like basic life support and measures for hospital infection control also conducted.

c. Orientation for the interns was held from  $7^{\text{th}}$  to  $9^{\text{th}}$  July 2022 for the regular batch, with 97 interns attending the same and for supplementary batch it was conducted on  $6^{\text{th}}$ &  $7^{\text{th}}$  January 2023.

d. PG orientation for 2021 batch was held on 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> May 2022 for 50 PG students and for the batch of 2022 it was held on 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2022, for 46 students,

# 2. Foundation Course

c. A Robing of the Cadaver ceremony was conducted on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2022 to indicate the end of dissection and as mark of respect to the cadaver from which the students got to learn.

d. As with previous years, Exit Exam for Interns was conducted for 95 outgoing interns on the 7<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022. Interns who needed improvement in must-know skills were given additional training and had to undergo reassessment until certified.

e. The NMC approved Revised Basic Course Workshop was conducted from 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> January 2023, for 28 faculty members. The workshop was conducted under the observer ship of the designated Regional Center JIPMER, Puducherry.
